Tanja Sarett, M.A, CFRE is a highly experienced nonprofit leader and development professional. She has worked in the nonprofit and foundation field for more than 20 years with organizations in the U.S, Germany and Israel.

Her expertise includes building fundraising capacity, increasing financial and programmatic viability, expanding visibility, and managing growth. Tanja's extensive experience in organizational leadership, strategic planning, program development, management and marketing equips her to create effective synergies between an organization's fundraising work and its critical success drivers, and to prepare nonprofits for the future.

Tanja's fundraising experience has focused on major gifts, individual and institutional giving, prospect research, moves management, annual campaigns, fundraising events, donor cultivation and stewardship, direct response, donor communications and emarketing.

Prior to joining Carter, Tanja served as a Program Officer at the Harold Grinspoon Foundation, a major international Jewish foundation. As a senior member of the fundraising team, Tanja maximized the philanthropist's multi-million-dollar investment and spearheaded growth, fundraising and communication strategies to strengthen the foundation and its flagship program PJ Library.

As a fundraiser for JASA, a social service agency for the elderly, and The Abraham Fund Initiative, Tanja built fundraising infrastructure and brought in funds through special events. Tanja's career path includes leadership positions with The International March of the Living, DGB Youth in Munich, and The International Youth Meeting at Dachau. She spent her early career at the German Museum in Munich, the Munich Youth Council and the International Munich Trade Fair Association.

Throughout her career, Tanja has engaged with many organizations and institutions, including cultural organizations and museums, youth organizations, social service agencies, labor unions, Jewish federations and community centers, international organizations, synagogues and churches, and foundations.
